

Emergency Plan – Information for Parents

During the	Inside:
earthquake	 Students and staff will drop, take cover under a strong structure (table/desk) and hold onto the legs until the shaking stops If no desk or table, drop, cover and hold next to an interior wall Do not move more than a few steps (no more than three metres) Keep away from shelves containing heavy objects and other large items of furniture Keep away from windows Stay indoors until the shaking stops and be guided by teachers Outdoors: Drop, cover and hold Students are to stay in the school grounds Keep away from buildings and power lines

emergency	 The continuing operation of the school will be determined by the nature of the emergency and the availability of resources such as buildings, employees and other resources
Lockdown	The lockdown of the school will be activated at a time when students
Procedures	need to be contained and protected inside school buildings. During a
	lockdown, all normal school operations stop and all personnel remain
	in their secure location until the all clear is given.

	 Reasons for a lockdown: An unarmed intruder inside the building A person on the school grounds who is posing a risk A chemical spill where students and staff are at risk of toxic inhalation if they go outside An incident in the area being managed by the Police
Lockdown Communication	During a lockdown, students will turn off their mobiles and other devices. Please do not try and contact your children. The school app will be used to advise parents the school is in lockdown. There will be regular updates using this tool. It is important to remember that parents are not to attempt to arrive at the school to remove their children. This poses a risk to themselves and to the police management of the situation.
	When the all clear is given, and if this is before the end of the school day, students will remain at school. If the lockdown occurs beyond school hours, students will be released as after clearance as possible. Boarders will remain in the care of boarding house staff as normal.
