#### ST MATTHEW'S COLLEGIATE SCHOOL SCHOOL DRIVING / PASSENGER LICENCE 2024

# ALL girls, whether they are boarders or day girls, MUST get a school driving licence if they want to drive to school.

### **CONDITIONS OF PERMIT**

- 1. Permission to drive to school is a privilege granted under special circumstances. This permission will be granted only after receipt of a letter of approval from a parent or guardian of the girl concerned and is also conditional on the approval of the Principal.
- 2. Permission to carry passengers is also a privilege and requires written approval from a parent or guardian of the driver and of each of the passengers. Once again, the approval of the Principal is also required.
- 3. Drivers must at all times obey the NZ road code and laws, along with the school driving rules.

#### **USE OF VEHICLES**

The following rules will apply to the use of motor vehicles by all students at, or in association with, St Matthew's Collegiate School, Rathkeale College or Senior College.

- Any student driving to school must possess a school driving licence. The student's driving licence must be sighted, and a photocopy supplied, when the application is lodged at the Principal's PA's office. This licence must be lodged by **Monday 19 February 2024.** Students who gain their licence during the year may get a licence at that time.
- 2. Y12 Day Students:
  - can drive only to and from St Matthew's. They must leave their cars outside the main gates at St Matthew's and catch the school bus to Senior College.
  - Y13 Day Students:
  - have permission to drive to Senior College at the start and end of the school day. *We recommend* in the first instance that students use school provided transport to travel between schools at the start and end of the school day.
- **3.** Y12 Boarding Students:
  - Y12 can only drive their cars to St Matthew's and home from St Matthew's . Y12 do not have permission to use their cars during the school week so must surrender their keys to the Boarding staff.
  - Y13 Boarding students:
  - Y13 may use their cars once parents and school have given permission.
- 4. Boarders' Parking Area
  - Y13 have first priority on the Hampton Boarders' carpark. Y12 must park on the road if no parks are available.
- 5. In very special circumstances Y12 students may obtain permission to drive their car to Senior College by using a 'permission slip' signed by either the Principal, Deputy Principal or Dean. *Evidence of the request is required* i.e. note from home, appointment card etc. The 'permission slip' is for the day of issue and <u>must be displayed clearly</u> on the car dashboard during the day.

#### All Students

- 1. Cars may not be driven in the school grounds at any time.
- 2. Students may not carry passengers to or from Senior College at any time.
- 3. Students must be aware that having a school licence is a privilege and may be revoked at any time. Students then have to go to school by alternative means.
- 4. If a student on a restricted licence carries students, not only will the student lose the right to drive for a period of time, but the police will be informed.
