Background

Findings

The school is a signatory provider to the *Education (Pastoral Care of Tertiary and International Learners) Code of Practice 2021* established under section 534 of the Education and Training Act 2020. The school has attested that it complies with all aspects of the Code and has completed an annual self-review of its implementation of the Code.

At the time of this review there were two international students attending the school.

International Students are accommodated in the school hostel, and collaboration between the Director of Boarding and the Director of International Students ensure they are well cared for. Pastoral care is responsive and proactive with students having access to a wide range of support.

Students experience opportunities to develop academically and socially and are well integrated into the wider sporting, cultural and leadership opportunities within the school.

The school provides programmes that enable students to achieve the high expectations they have for academic success and pathways beyond school. Reports to the Board could be enhanced by reporting on a more regular basis and including achievement and progress data.

Internal evaluation processes are effective with a focus on enhancing the international experience for students. Students and their families are provided with opportunities to give feedback, and emerging issues are addressed.
